IIDA Texas/Oklahoma Chapter Announces Study Abroad Grant

Dallas, Texas – The Texas Oklahoma Chapter of the International Interior Design Association (IIDA) announces their Study Abroad Grant has opened for applicant submissions through Wednesday, April 1, 2009. The grant is available for interior design undergraduate and graduate students within their 3rd and 4th years of study at a CIDA (formerly FIDER) accredited university within Texas and Oklahoma. A total of two (2) grants are available, with each grant totaling \$3,000.

The Texas Oklahoma Chapter Education Fund was established in 2006 through the IIDA Foundation. The IIDA Foundation is a not-for-profit philanthropic organization whose primary mission is to advance interior design through education, research and knowledge to benefit IIDA and the interior design profession. In addition to the Study Abroad Grant, the Texas Oklahoma Chapter will be providing a Tuition Reimbursement Grant in late Spring 2009.
