## **IIDA Texas/Oklahoma Chapter Announces Tuition Reimbursement Grant**

Dallas, Texas – The Texas/Oklahoma Chapter of the International Interior Design Association (IIDA) announces their Tuition Reimbursement Grant is now open for applicant submissions through Thursday, May 1, 2008. The grant is available for interior design graduate and undergraduate students within their 3rd and 4th years of study at a CIDA (formerly FIDER) accredited university within Texas and Oklahoma. A total of two (2) grants are available, with each grant totaling \$3,000.

The Texas/Oklahoma Chapter Education Fund was established in 2006 through the IIDA Foundation. The IIDA Foundation is a not-for-profit philanthropic organization whose primary mission is advancing interior design through education, research and knowledge to benefit the IIDA and the interior design profession. The Tuition Reimbursement Grant is in addition to the Study Abroad Grant awarded earlier this year.
